

STORED PRODUCT PESTS - TREATMENT GUIDE

Stored product pests have either come in with a food product or entered your home from the outside. It is critical to get rid of all contaminated materials in order to properly remove these pests.

CLEANING:

IS SOMETHING LEFT TO THE TENANT OR HOMEOWNER. This must be done at the beginning in order for us to deliver proper treatment. Below is a list of items to clean over the treatment period; we may add to this list over time as we deem necessary - this is a starting guide.

EMPTY AND CLEAN CABINETS. Crumbs and food spills from stored food products provide an excellent source of food for these pests. Thoroughly clean the cabinets and remove food spills. UPPER CUPBOARDS included. If you have any liners, remove and discard.

As soon as the contaminated food is removed, these pests will leave and/or die.

KEEP FOOD IN SEALED CONTAINERS. These pests can get into cardboard packaging and loosely closed boxes and plastic bags. Store food in metal, glass, or hard plastic seal-able containers.

EMPTY PET FOOD CONTAINERS OVERNIGHT OR COVER TIGHTLY. These pest could have come in with pet food and will use water sources.
